

ARMY OFFICER

QUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ GCSEs
 - Must include grade C in English Language, Maths and either a Science or Modern Foreign Language
 - Average 7 x C grades
- ► A minimum of 180 UCAS Points is needed
- ➤ A levels should include:
 - ➤ 2 x A2 subjects at grade E or above
 - Average CCC at A2
- ► 80% of entrants are graduates

DEFENCE 6TH FORM COLLEGE WELBECK

- ➤ Sixth form education for potential technical officers
- ► 40 GCSE points required including an A grade in Maths
- ► Must be able to take three A2s including Maths and Physics
- ► Apply by 15 November in year 11
- ➤ Technical bursary at university (£4000 per year)
- Guaranteed place at Sandhurst for successful students



ARMY OFFICER SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

ARMY OFFICER SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

- ► Apply in Year 12 (first year of 6th Form)
- ► Selection Board in July each year
- ► £3000 to cover your two sixth form years
- ➤ Automatic enrolment on the Undergraduate Bursary Scheme conditional upon meeting the requirements
- ➤ You need:
 - ► 46 points in seven best GCSE subjects
 - ► Pass a 24 hour selection process
- ▶ Commitment to Short Service Commission in the Army

TRAIN AT THE ARMY FOUNDATION COLLEGE HARROGATE

- ➤ You must be between 16 and 17 years 5 months when you join
- ➤ 2 types of course
 - ➤ 40 weeks training plus 8 weeks holiday for Infantry, Royal Armoured Corps, Royal Artillery and some Royal Logistic Corps roles
 - ➤ 20 weeks training plus 3 weeks holiday for Technical trades
- ► Combination of military, academic and adventurous training
- ➤ On completion of course you will go to your special Army training course





THE END PRODUCT









FURTHER EDUCATION BURSARY SCHEME

- ► Additional funding for students studying some FE subjects
- Awarded while they are studying and after their initial Army training
- ► You must:
 - ► Be aged between 16 and 32
 - ► Complete Phase 1 training
- ➤ The FEB is worth £1,000 per year of study to a maximum of 2 years and £1,500 (taxable) on completion of Phase 1 Training




